NEW: DESIGNATION FOR GIFTS OF ANY SIZE

Effective Jan. 1, 2011, donors contributing less than \$1,000 to the Annual Campaign have the option to designate 50% of their gifts to any partner organization(s), with 50% directed to OREF. Contributors will receive a 2011 donor lapel pin and recognition in OREF's annual report.

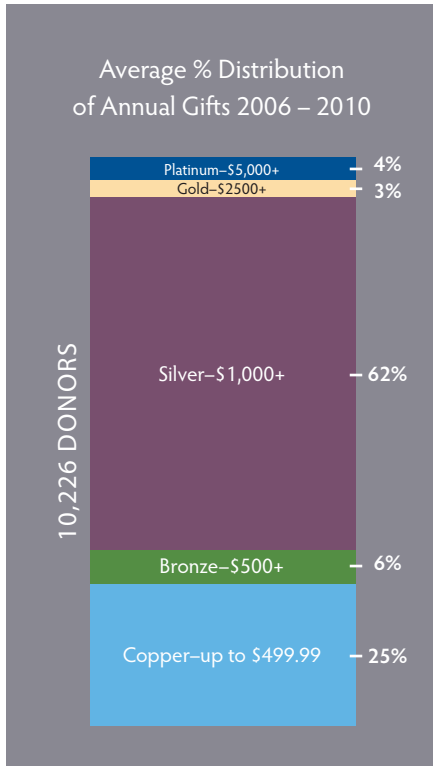
Options for residents

Order of Merit

For donors making Annual Campaign contributions at the Order of Merit level of \$1,000 or more, the sharing plan remains unchanged. A minimum of \$500 is directed to OREF, and any additional amount may be directed to any partner organization(s).
